In the present matter issue of limitation is involved. As Hon'ble Supreme Court is seized of the matter and Hon'ble Supreme Court in its order dated 16.12.2025 has been pleased to state that the pendency of claim petition would not come in the way of matter being taken up by the Tribunal except at the final decision/passing of judgment.

In view of order of Hon'ble Supreme Court, Tribunal is *prima facie* of the opinion that notice can be issued.

In compliance of Rule 8 (2) (b) of Delhi MACT Rules, 2008, on behalf of petitioner evidence by way of affidavit of Ms. Archana/petitioner no.1 along with list of witnesses filed.

With respect to eye witness, Ld. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the details of eye witness would be given after filing of charge-sheet and undertakes that no witness other than mentioned in the charge-sheet would be examined in support of claim petition.

In view of undertaking, **issue notice of the claim petition to all the respondents on filing of PF through all permissible modes.**
