1. Further status report has been filed by IO. Taken on record.
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2. Submissions heard.

3. Ld. Defence Counsel has submitted that accused has already
joined the investigation and that his custodial interrogation was not
required.

4. Ld. Substitute Addl. PP assisted by IO has submitted that IO/SI
Ankit Sagar had visited the matrimonial home of the complainant at
Morena, MP alongwith her on 15.05.2025 for recovery of her *stridhan*,
documents and other related articles. It has been submitted that 29 admitted
dowry articles were handed over to the complainant after preparing seizure
memo of the same in the presence of the parties. It has been submitted that
no jewelry or any other document as stated by the complainant could be
recovered from there. Further, accused has already joined the investigation
and has been bound down as per directions of Hon'ble Apex Court after
interrogation.

5. I have considered the submissions from both the sides alongwith record.

6. Allegations against the accused/applicant herein are pertaining to commission of offences U/s 498A/406/34 IPC. He has already joined the investigation and has been bound down by Investigating Officer in terms of judgment of Hon'ble Apex Court in **Arnesh Kumar Vs. State of Bihar & Anr**, AIR 2014 SC 2756.

7. Considering the above including nature of offence, application stands allowed. It is directed that in the event of arrest, the applicant **Raj Kumar Singh Tomar** be released on bail, on furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 20,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of concerned SHO/IO. This order of anticipatory bail is subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) the applicant shall join the investigation as and when directed to do so;
- (ii) the applicant shall intimate the Court in case of change of his address;
- (iii) the applicant shall not leave the country without permission of the Court.

The application stands disposed of accordingly.
