Taking into consideration the nature of offence and circumstances, I proceed to pass the following order-

ORDER

1. The accused is convicted under section 252 of the B.N.S.S. on his own voluntarily plead guilty for the offence punishable u/s **section 12(a) of the Bombay Prevention of Gambling Act** and he is sentenced till rising of court sentenced and to pay fine of Rs.800/- (In words Rs. Eight hundred only), in default, to suffer simple imprisonment for 2 days.
2. Seized muddemal i.e. amount of Rs.780/- (In words Rs. Seven Hundred Eighty only) be credited to Government.
