APPLICATION UNDER SECTION 372 OF THE INDIAN SUCCESSION
ACT FOR GRANT OF SUCCESSION CERTIFICATE

- J U D G M E N T -

[Delivered on 19.06.2026]

This is an application for grant of Succession Certificate under Section 372 of the Indian Succession Act, 1921.

2] In short, the applicants have come up with the case that

applicant No.1 is wife and applicants No. 2 & 3 are sons of deceased Bhagwan Jijabhau alias Jija Nagare. Deceased Bhagwan Jijabhau alias Jija Nagare died on 04.01.2025 at Mouje Khorwad, Taluka- Mantha, District- Satara. The applicants are the only legal heirs of deceased Bhagwan. In his lifetime deceased Bhagwan was having saving account in the Maharashtra Gramin Bank, Branch- Talni, Tq. Mantha, bearing account No.80024746206 and Rs.40,690/- is balance in said account. Thus after his death, the applicants need said amount for their daily needs. Applicants are the only legal heirs of deceased Bhagwan Nagare and are entitled for the receipt of said amount. Therefore, the applicants prayed to grant succession certificate for the said purpose.

3] The paper publication vide Ex.11 was made in the daily newspaper 'Jagmitra' dated 09th May, 2026 and objections were called upon to be filed within one month. So also, notice was affixed on conspicuous place of the Court. But, none appeared to contest the matter and accordingly this application is being disposed of as uncontested one.

4] I have heard the learned advocate for the applicants. The applicants have examined applicant No.2 in support of their contention and relied upon documents viz. Evidence on affidavit of applicant No. 2 at Exh.08. They have filed death certificate of deceased Bhagwan Jijabhau alias Jija Nagare at Exh.12, the copies of Adhar Card of applicants are at Exh.13 to 15, copy of bank account at Exh. 16. The news paper publication in Jagmitra Dt. 09/05/2026 is at Exh.11. The Applicants have closed their evidence vide pursis at Exh.17. These documents show that the applicants are legal heirs of deceased

Bhagwan. Applicant No. 1 deposed that the succession certificate of the deceased is required for the amount lying in the bank account of deceased Bhagwan. As per the contention of applicants, Rs.40,690/- is lying in the bank account of deceased Bhagwan.

5] There is no denial to the evidence of the applicants. So also, there is no objection raised by anybody. The applicants have furnished necessary documents to succeed their claim.

6] Upshot of the above, I have no reason to disbelieve the version of applicants on oath and, therefore, applicants will be entitled for getting succession certificate as requested for. Thus, the above referred evidence makes it clear that the applicants are entitled for succession certificate. In the result, I pass the following order.

ORDER

1. Applicants namely 1) **Kamalbai Bhagwan Nagare**, 2) **Santosh Bhagwan Nagare** & 3) **Uddhav Bhagwan Nagare**, are declared as entitled for Succession Certificate.
2. Issue Succession Certificate to the above applicants in respect of the amount in saving account No. 80024746206 of deceased Bhagwan Jijabhau alias Jija Nagare pending in Maharashtra Gramin Bank, branch-Talni, after payment of requisite stamp and court fees, if any.
3. Nazir/A.S. to verify the valuation required for issuing Succession Certificate.
