Cri.Bail.Application no.120/2026

Order below Exh.1



Applicant Malappa Saibana Hosmani has filed this regular bail application under section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita. He is in judicial custody in pursuance of Crime No.625/2025 registered against him at police station, Juna Rajwada, Kolhapur on 23/10/2025 under sections 331(3), 331(4) and 305(a) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (corresponding to sections 454, 457 and 380 of the Indian Penal Code). The grounds for bail are stated in the application.

02. The application is opposed by the prosecution by filing say.

03. Learned advocate for the applicant submitted that the accused has been chargesheeted. Investigation in the crime is completed. He be released on bail.

04. Learned A.P.P. submitted that the applicant is having criminal past. If he is released on bail he will repeat the offence.

05. On 23-10-2025 Arvind Laxman Shete reported to the In-charge of police station, Juna Rajwada that on 22-10-2022 between 8 p.m. and 10-45 p.m. some unknown person entered in his bedroom in absence of him and his family members, removed the grills of the window and stole 34 tola gold ornaments, 1.400 kg. Silver ornaments, coins and cash amount. This information led to

registration of crime against an unknown person and its investigation started.

06. The applicant came to be arrested. During the memorandum statement, the applicant expressed to show the shop of goldsmith, to whom he sold the gold ornaments. The applicant took the Investigation Officer and other police staff to Mahadeo Jewelles at Pune. The golden ornaments stolen from the house of the informant are seized from the said shop vide seizure panchanama dated 27-01-2026. The ornaments seized at the instance of the applicant are identified by informant Arvind and his wife Ujwala. The moped which was used by the applicant to reach Kolhapur from Pune is also seized at his instance. Thus, prima facie case of doing theft in dwelling house of the informant by the applicant is made out. The applicant has previously committed similar kind of offences in various police stations at Pune. They all are still pending. If the applicant is released on bail there is every chance repetition of crime at his instance. No case is made out to grant him bail. In the result, following order is passed -

Application is rejected.
