Cri.Bail.Application No.153/2026**Order below Exh.1**

Applicant Amar Hindurao Khamkar has filed this regular bail application under section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita. He is in judicial custody in pursuance of Crime no.27/2026, registered at police station, Kodoli, Dist.Kolhapur under sections 74, 75(2), 76, 78, 118(1), 125, 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 3(5) of The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (corresponding to sections 354, 354-A, 354-B, 354-D, 324, 336, 341, 323, 504, 506 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code). The grounds for bail are stated in the application.

02. The application is opposed by the prosecution by submitting say.

03. It is case of the prosecution against applicant that on 1-1-2026 at 8-45 a.m. informant had been to Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Statue, Warnanagar. The applicant came there with his blue colour tractor. He tried to intercept the victim's Activa motorcycle by his tractor, she stopped it. The applicant got down from the tractor, came near her, caught her hand, pressed her chest and demand for physical relationship. The victim had frightened and pushed the applicant. The applicant then ran away. She narrated the incident to her husband and lodged the F.I.R. about the incidents dated 19-12-2025 and 1-2-2026 on 4-2-2026.

04. Learned advocate for the applicant submitted that

offence is registered against the applicant with ulterior motive. The applicant has no criminal past. He is ready to abide conditions. He be released on bail.

05. It is submitted on behalf of the State that serious offence has been committed by the applicant. If he is released on bail, there is every chance of his threatening to the victim.

06. It appears from the contents in the F.I.R. that the victim and the applicant knew each other since before incident. The victim stood guarantor to the loan obtained by the applicant's mother. The applicant's mother could not repay the loan. The victim was pursuing him to pay the installments of the loan. Due to this, the applicant had grudge against the victim. One agreement was executed between them. On 19-12-2025 the applicant had been to the field of the victim and caught her hand and manhandled her. The victim and her husband had suffered bleeding injuries during this incident. This matter was settled by the intervention of some villagers.

07. The investigation papers show that spot panchanama is conducted. Statements of witness Amarjeet, Raju Patil are recorded. The document i.e. the agreement executed between the victim and the applicant is seized by the police. Practically, the investigation in the crime is completed. The F.I.R. is lodged four days after the incident. Possibility of lodging the F.I.R. after due deliberation cannot be ruled out. The applicant has no criminal antecedents. He has roots in the society. He is entitled to get bail

with conditions. In the result, following order is passed -

Order

- 1 Application is allowed.
- 2 Applicant be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rs.Twenty Five Thousand only) with the surety in the like amount.
- 3 He shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to the victim and shall not contact her, directly or indirectly.
- 4 He shall appear before the in-charge Police Station, as and when called for.
- 5 Applicant/accused to comply as per Chapter-I Para 12 of the Criminal Manual.
- 6 Bail before the learned Magistrate.
