**Cri.Bail Application No.155/2026**



**Order below Exh.1**

Applicant Aaditya Avinash Ranadive is seeking relief of regular bail under section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita. Crime No.98/2026 is registered against him and others under sections 109, 352 read with 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (corresponding sections of 307 and 504 of I.P.C.), section 5 read with 27 of the Arms Act at police station, Shahupuri on 06-02-2026. The grounds for bail are stated in the application.

02. The application is objected by the prosecution by submitting say. According to the prosecution, witness Harshwardhan is still under treatment. If the applicant is released on bail, there is possibility of threatening of the witnesses.

03. Heard both the sides and perused the record.

04. The F.I.R. is authored by Shivaji Chougule on 6-2-2026, wherein he alleged that on 5-2-2026 he, Harshwardhan Kondekar, Sohan Aawle, Ritesh Savarde came to Koklhapur at 6 p.m. Aaditya Randive (the applicant) called Harshwardhan and asked him to come at Alexa Park. When they all went there one person was standing there. He was Aaditya Randive. Harshwardhan and Sohan went towards him. He and Ritesh stood back at some distance. When talks were going on between Harshwardhan and Aaditya, Omkar and one person came near Aaditya. There was exchanges of abuses. When Harshwardhan and Sohan were coming back, suddenly Aaditya said

“ओंकार, यांना जिवंत सोडायचे नाही, ठार मारा”. Omkar rushed towards Harshwardhan and Sohan with knife. When Harshwardhan saw back, Omkar thrust knife in his stomach. When Sohan rushed ahead, Omkar thrust knife in his stomach. Thereafter Omkar, Aaditya and one person with them ran away. Ritesh went away with Harshwardhan on his motorcycle. He admitted Sohan Aawale in the hospital.

05. The cross F.I.R. is authored by the applicant against Harshwardhan and three unknown persons. This F.I.R. substantiates presence of the applicant at the place of incident. Witness Uday has specifically stated against the applicant that the applicant instigated Omkar and thereafter Omkar rushed towards Harshwardhan and thrust knife in his stomach. He also injured Sohan by thrusting knife in his stomach. Witness Vinod Kondekar has corroborated version in the F.I.R. Looking to the serious nature of the crime and undisputed presence of the applicant at the spot, this Court is of the view that no case is made out by the applicant to get bail. In the result, following order is passed -

**Order**

Application stands rejected.
