Cri.Bail. Application No.216/2026Order below Exh.1

Applicants/accused Tushar Sarang Kamble is arrayed as an accused in Crime no.8/2026, registered at police station, Karveer, Dist. Kolhapur under sections 80, 85, 108, 352 read with 3(5) of the B.NS. (corresponding Sections 304B, 498-A, 306 and 504 read with 34 of the Indian penal code). By way of this application he is seeking relief of regular bail on the grounds mentioned in the application.

02. The application is opposed by the prosecution by submitting say.

03. The applicant is the husband of the deceased, who committed suicide on 6-1-2026. She married to the applicant in the year 2019. The F.I.R. is authored by the mother of the deceased on 7-1-2026. She alleged against the applicant in the F.I.R that after marriage his daughter Pratiksha and the applicant were cohabiting peacefully for two years. Child Sharvil born out of the wedlock between them. Thereafter, the applicant used to come to home under influence of liquor and torture her on the cause that she had an extra marital affair. He did not provide her money or house expenses and prevented her from doing job of the nurse. On 13-12-2025, during the marriage ceremony of Prabhakar Kamble, the applicant beat Pratiksha. Due to harassment at the hands of the applicant and his father,

Pratiksha committed suicide by hanging herself.

04. After registration of the crime applicant was arrested on 7-1-2016 and he was remanded to police custody for some days. During this, interrogation was made with the applicant. Since more than 2 months the applicant is in judicial custody. Material investigation against him is completed and filing of the chargesheet is only remained. Whether suicide of Pratiksha was result of harassment at the hands of the applicant and his father will be decided during the trial. This is not fit case to keep the applicant in judicial custody for indefinite period on the basis of allegations made in the F.I.R. against him. He is admitted to bail with conditions. In the result, following order is passed -

### **ORDER**

1. The application is allowed.
2. Applicant be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in sum of Rs.25,000/- with solvent surety in the like amount.
3. He shall not tamper with the evidence and threat the witnesses, directly or indirectly.
4. He shall appear before the In-charge of concerned Police Station, as and when called for.
5. Applicant to comply as per Chapter-I Para 12 of the Criminal Manual.
6. Bail before the learned Magistrate.
