**Common order below Exh.1 in**  
**Cri.Bail.Application No.229/2026 & 230/2026**

Applicants Kiran Shankar Hirve( B.A.No.229/26) and Akash Dadu Korvi (B.A.No.230/26) are seeking regular bail under section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita. They are in judicial custody in pursuance C. R. No.38/2026 registered against them at police station, Panhala Dist.Kolhapur on 05/03/2026 under sections 306, 323, 504, 506 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code, sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s) and 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities Act, 1989) (hereinafter Atrocity Act) and sections 6, 39 and 45 of the Maharashtra Money Lending (Regulation) Act. The applicants have sought bail on the grounds mentioned in the application.

02. The applications are opposed by the prosecution by filing say.

03. Informant has filed her affidavit and opposed the bail applications.

04. It appears that the deceased committed suicide on 23-09-2023. The accidental death report was given in its respect and due inquiry was conducted. Nobody was held responsible. The crime is registered against the applicants on 5-3-2026 i.e. more than 3 years

after the deceased committed the suicide. It is alleged against the applicants that they were instrumental in abetting the deceased to commit suicide. There was some money transaction between the deceased and applicant no.1. The deceased could not pay the amount. It is alleged against applicants that they gave caste abuses to the deceased and family of the informant on the cause of money. No specific date of caste abuses is mentioned in the F.I.R. Possibility of false implication of the applicants at the hands of the informant by giving colour of criminal prosecution to the civil dispute cannot be ruled out. No criminal antecedents are at the discredit of the applicants. They are entitled to get bail with conditions. In the result, following order is passed.

**Order**

- 1 Applications are allowed.
- 2 Applicants be released on bail on their execution of a personal bond in sum of Rs.25,000/- each and solvent surety in the like amount .
- 3 They shall not threat the witnesses and tamper with the prosecution evidence.
- 4 They shall appear before the in-charge Police Station, as and when called for.
- 5 Applicants/accused to comply as per Chapter-I Para 12 of the Criminal Manual.
