


<p>MHKO010010472026</p> 	<p><u>Order passed below Exh. 1 in</u> <u>Cri. Misc. Appln. No.55/2026</u> <u>(State of Maharashtra Vs. Nilesh Krushnath Shinde)</u></p>

1. The applicant is seeking custody of the seized two wheeler Splendor plus motorcycle bearing Registration No. MH-09-EF-3377, Chassis No. MBLHACGGHJ30677, Engine No. HA10ERGHJ41752 which has been seized during investigation in C.R. No.27/2026, registered with the Panhala Police Station, Dist-Kolhapur.
2. It is contended that, the applicant is registered owner of the said vehicle and if the vehicle is kept lying at the police station for indefinite period, it may get damaged due to weather conditions. The applicant has undertaken, not to make any changes in the appearance of the said vehicle or alienate the same. The applicant is ready to abide by any conditions that may be imposed.
3. The State has filed say at Exh.4, but has not raised any specific ground of objection.
4. I have heard both the sides.
5. The applicant has placed on record copy of the R. C. Book which transpires that, the two wheeler Splendor plus motorcycle bearing Registration No. MH-09-EF-3377 is registered in the name of the applicant Nilesh Shinde, who is accused in C. R.

No.27/2026. He has placed verified copies of his PAN Card and insurance policy on record. It appears that, the vehicle is insured for the period from 11/03/2026 to 10/03/2027. The applicant is thus registered owner. There is possibility that, the vehicle may get damaged due to the weather conditions, if it is detained in the police station for a long period. It may take considerable time in deciding the case on merits and it will be in the larger interest of the justice to return the vehicle to the applicant, on indemnity bond and conditions. Hence, I pass the following order:

ORDER

- (1) The application is allowed.
- (2) The two wheeler Splendor plus motorcycle bearing Registration No. MH-09-EF-3377, Chassis No. MBLHACGGHJ30677, Engine No. HA10ERGHJ4172 , seized in C.R. No.27/2026, registered with the Panhala Police Station, Dist-Kolhapur, be returned to the applicant-accused Nilesh Krushnath Shinde on following conditions:
 - (a) That the applicant shall execute indemnity bond (suprutnama) of Rs.50,000/- (Rs. Fifty Thousand only).
 - (b) The applicant shall not make any material change in the appearance of the vehicle and shall not sell or dispose it of without permission of this court.
 - (c) The applicant shall produce the said vehicle as and when directed by this Court.

(3) Issue letter to the concerned Police Station on compliance by the applicant-accused.
