1. 1] Present application is filed by respondent No.1 to set aside the “No cross” order passed against her on the evidence affidavit of the applicant. It is contended that the husband of respondent No.1 was sick and so she could not remain present in the court and as such “No cross” order was passed.

2] On present application strong objection is taken by the applicant that the application is false one. The respondent purposely avoided to conduct the cross-examination. Delay is caused to harass the applicant. As such he prayed to reject the application.

3] Now though the respondent has not filed any documentary evidence to substantiate her contention, but to decide the main application on merit and also in the interest of justice opportunity needs to be granted to the respondent, but subject to costs for causing delay. Accordingly, following order.

O R D E R

1. Application is allowed.
2. No cross order passed against respondent be set aside subject to cost of Rs.500/- to be paid to the applicant.

3. The respondent to conduct the cross-examination without seeking further time.
