Order passed below Exh. 8 in Special Case
No.217/2025
(State of Maharashtra Vs. Sunil Shreepati Kurane)

The victim has given this application stating that she was under pressure and was scared that the accused may cause harm to her family members i.e. her mother and younger brother. Therefore, she had refused to her medical examination. However, now she is at safe location and is ready for medical examination. She has given the application out of her own will and has requested to conduct the medical examination. Ld. APP Smt. Jadhav argued that medical examination of the victim is necessary.

2. The accused opposed the application on the ground that the investigation is complete and the charge-sheet is filed. At that time, minor victim had refused for medical examination. It is possible that she is being pressurized now.

3. Heard both the sides. Ld. Advocate for the the accused submitted that love letters exchanged between the victim and the accused are filed along with the charge-sheet. The victim is minor and admittedly the accused is 50 years old. Thus, it does not appear to be the case of consensual relationship between young teenagers. Considering all the facts and circumstances of the case, further investigation in the matter is necessary. Hence, I pass following order.

ORDER

- (1) The application is allowed.
- (2) Investigating Officer is directed to carry out further investigation in this matter and medical examination of the minor victim be conducted at C. P. R. Hospital, Kolhapur and report be submitted to this court.
- (3) Inform concerned Police Station.
