

**Order below Bail Application of accused in R.C.C.No.479/2012**  
**registered with Juna Rajwada Police Station**

01. The present application filed by accused for release him on bail.

02. It is contention of the accused that he is suffering from high blood pressure and diabetes. There are three eye operations of accused. Therefore, he could not remain present in the court and hence prayed for release him on bail and filed application accordingly.

03. The learned A.P.P. filed his say and contended that the record of the case reveals that accused has not given regular bail in this case as he was released on anticipatory bail in the year 2010 with specific condition that he must give regular bail in the court after the submission of charge-sheet. The charge-sheet submitted in the year 2012. Since then at any point of time he did not appear before this court. In addition he submitted that contention raised in the application are not supported by any documentary proof or any medical certificate. Hence prayed to reject to application being frivolous.

04. On perusal of the record the charge leveled against accused are u/s.193, 342, 467, 468, 471, 420, 323, 504, 506, 409, 511 r/w. 34 of I.P.C. are serious in nature. As contended by A.P.P. accused has not turned to this court for regular bail. He has brought before this court in execution of N.B.W. Though this be the situation the charge-sheet is already submitted. Hence, no purpose will be served by keeping accused behind bars. Hence, I proceed to pass following order:-

**Order**

1. The application is allowed.
2. Accused namely Manik Lalchand Gandhi be released on furnishing P.R. and bond of Rs.15,000/- and surety bond of like amount subject to the condition that he will remain present during the trial on every date.
3. Inform Juna Rajwada police station accordingly.
