Reg. Cri. Case No. 2300/2020

(State of Maharashtra Vs Akash alias Sonya Rama Bodake)

Read the applications and say filed on them. Heard the learned counsel for both the side. In this case, charge sheet is filed alleging the offences punishable under sections 324, 323, and 504 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. Since 30.04.2021, accused No.2 was absent, and NBW came to be issued against him on 22.11.2022. Today, he suo moto appeared and sought the cancellation of NBW as well as grant of bail. The offences are bailable in nature. It is seen from the documents filed along with list (Exh.26) that, accused No.2 is suffering from liver problem since long and presently, his liver functions around 22 % and even he could not in position to walk without support. It is also fact that, during 2021 and upto February, 2022, there was lock down due to Covid and relaxation for the appearance in the court proceeding. Today, the learned counsel for accused No.2 submitted that, hereinafter accused No.2 would regularly attend the court and cooperate it for earliest disposal of the old case. Hence, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and that, the alleged offences are bailable in nature, NBW against accused No.2 is cancelled is subject to penalty of Rs.2000/- and he is being released on PB and SB of Rs.15,000/- with condition that, he shall not abscond and tamper with the prosecution evidence. He shall submit his correct permanent address, phone number, and e-mail if any.
