APPLICATION UNDER RULE 2 & 3 OF BOMBAY  
REGULATION VIII ACT, 1827 FOR GRANT OF  
LEGAL HEIRSHIP CERTIFICATE

**J U D G M E N T****[Delivered today on 08.06.2026]**

1. The Applicant nos. 1 and 2 have made this application under Rule 2 & 8 of Bombay Regulation VIII Act, 1827.
2. It is stated in the application that, mother of the applicant no.1 and wife of applicant no.2 **Late. Ankita Rupchand Maheshwari** demised on 11/08/2024. It is mentioned in the application that for the purpose of further legal proceedings heirship certificate is required. Hence, the present application is made.
3. On receipt of the case, an order passed below Exh.1 for publication of public notice in a widely circulated regional newspaper inviting objections on claim of the applicants, if any. Accordingly, it appears that applicant have published the notice in regional Newspaper '*Dainik Mahasattha*' of 19<sup>th</sup> February 2026. The paper publication is available at Exh.8/1. Since then, no objections have been raised by anybody as to the claim of the applicants.
4. Thereafter, applicant no.2 filed his affidavit of evidence vide Exh.9. The applicant no.1 also produced death certificate of his wife (original copy) at Exh.3/1, birth certificate of applicant no.1 (original copy) at Exh.3/2, aadhar card of applicant no.1 (original copy) at Exh.3/3, aadhar card of applicant no.2 (xerox copy) at Exh.3/4, passport of applicant no.2 (Original copy) at Exh.3/5, letter issued by Chanakya, Ichalkaranji cemetery at Exh.3/6. Thereafter, the applicants closed their evidence vide *pursis* at Exh.10.
5. Heard Ld. Advocate for the applicants.
6. The Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827 was enacted to provide formal recognition of heirs, executors and administrators and also for appointment of Administrator/Manager of property by the Court. As mentioned rightly, the regulation formally recognizes right of a heir of the deceased person. Rule 2 of the Regulation provides that if no sufficient objection is offered, the Court will proceed to receive proof about right of the applicant and, if satisfied, grant certificate of heirship. Rule 3 is also on the same line and it provides that if no sufficient objection has been made within the expiry of time mentioned in the proclamation, heirship certificate can be granted on satisfaction of the Court.

7. In present case, the death of mother of the applicant no.1 and wife of applicant no.2 is established by death certificate and assertions of the applicants. It is highlighted that, heirship certificate is sought for the legal purposes/ obtaining Government documents etc. The assertions of applicants are intact as nobody has objected their claim. However, it is pertinent to note that object of heirship certificate is to give recognition to the status of applicants as an heir of the deceased. It does not confer any right relating to any property. Considering the record, I am of the view that the certificate of heirship may be granted in favour of the applicants. Thus, I find no reason to reject or refuse certification. Therefore, I pass the following order;

**ORDER**

Issue heirship certificate in the name of applicants;

1) Aarvik Rupchand Maheshwari and 2) Rupchand Shivprasad Maheshwari as *formally recognized heir* of deceased Late. **Ankita Rupchand Maheshwari**, in view of Rule 2 and 3 of Bombay Regulation VIII, 1827, in prescribed form available in the Schedule of Regulation on payment of requisite Court fees.
