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The instant application is filed by applicant no.1 & 2 under Protection of Women From Domestic Violence Act 2005 for grant of interim maintenance.

2. Perused the application and reply filed by the non-applicant below Exh12. Heard learned counsel Mr. A. S. Ruikar for applicant and learned counsel Mr. R. R. Bandar appearing for non-applicants.

3. According to the applicants, the relationship between the applicants and non-applicant no.1 is not disputed. The applicant no.1 is the legally wedded wife of non-applicant no.1. After marriage she was subjected to acts of domestic violence by all the non-applicants. The applicant has submitted in detail the acts constituting the domestic violence subjected to her by the non-applicants. The applicant has submitted that she is residing separately due to said acts from the non-applicant no.1.

4. The applicants further submitted that the non-applicant no.1 is centering contractor. Non-applicants have three hotels. They earn around Rs.3,50,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Fifty Thousand Only) per month. According to the applicant no.1, she is

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unemployed and her economic condition is weak. Applicants are in need of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand Only) per month for her survival and basic necessities. Accordingly, the applicants prays for grant of interim maintenance to the tune of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand Only) per month.

5. Per contra the non-applicant has submitted that he is not working anywhere and he earns Rs.3,000/- per month from labour work. Both the parties have filed their respective assets and liabilities affidavit on record. However, perusal of both of them does not disclose the actual income of non-applicant.

6. The applicant has not filed on record any concrete proof of source of income of non-applicant. So also the non-applicant has not filed on record anything which can show that the applicant is able to maintain herself.

7. Thus, considering pleadings, social economic status and responsibility of both sides some quantum of interim maintenance needs to be awarded to applicants for their livelihood. Hence, I proceed to pass following order -

ORDER

1) Application is allowed.

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- 2) Non-applicant to pay interim maintenance of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand Only) per month to applicant no.1 and Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) per month to applicant no.2 from the date of filing application till further order.
