ORDER BELOW EXH.1

The matter is listed for cross-examination of the complainant. Chief examination of the complainant was recorded on 19/09/2025. Since then the matter is pending for cross-examination. Despite giving sufficient opportunity, favourable dates to the complainant, he failed to appear before the Court. The accused and his Ld. Advocate are consistently present before the Court on dates fixed for trial. It certainly causes harassment to the opposite party. It appears that the complainant lost his interest in the present matter. Hence, the following order is passed;

ORDER

01. The complaint is dismissed and the accused is acquitted of the offences punishable under Sec. 3 (1) (zz) (viii), r.w. 3 (1) (z) r.w. 23, r.w. 26 (1), r.w. 26 (2) (i), r.w. 27 (1), rules 2.12 Part 2 Food safety standard (food product standard and food additives) Regulation, 2011 r.w. rules 3.1.2 (1), 3.1.2 (6) Part 3 food safety standard (food product standard and food additives) Regulation, 2011 r.w. Food category system no.15.1 r.w. rules 5.1 to 5.10 Labeling and display regulation, 2020 vide Sec. 256 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

02. The matter be disposed of accordingly.
