State Vs. Gajanan Aaglawe and others

Order Below Exh. 13 in SCC No.1254/2023

1] Perused the application. Heard Ld. APP and Advocate for the accused no 2 Mayur Shivaji Aawale. Gone through the affidavit of accused no.2.

2] Accused no.2 namely Mr. Mayur Shivaji Aawale submitted that, he is permanent resident of Ichalkaranji. On the account of his business he has to travel throughout India and abroad in his routing course of his business. It is further contended that accused No.2 is having passport which is due for renewal. However, the police and passport authorities are not renewing and issuing passports on the ground of pendency of present case and insisted accused to bring no objections/ order permitting renewal of passport. Under these circumstances, if the renewal or issuance of passport is withheld on account of pendency of this case when accused is ready to furnish sufficient surety, then the personal life and liberty of the accused shall be jeopardized resulting into loss and mental agony. The business of the accused is also likely to be hampered seriously. Hence, he requested to renew his passport.

3] Say of the complainant called but complainant failed to file his say. Hence, application is proceeded without say of complainant.

4] Perused the application. Alleged offence is registered against the accused persons for offence p/u/s.12-A of the Maharashtra Gambling Act. Plea of the accused is recorded. Matter is for evidence. Considering the case and offenses leveled against the accused, it is just and proper to grant the permission to the ac-

cused for renewal of passport. Mere pending criminal case is not ground to reject permission to renew passport. Hence, I pass following order.

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.
2. Passport authority is directed to renew the passport of accused No.2 Mayur Shivaji Aawale.
