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ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT - 01.

Application for the issuance of Heir-ship Certificate is raised under section 2 of the Bombay Regulation Act, 1827.

2. According to the applicant, her sister Shobha Bandu Shelake was died on 15.11.2020 at Ichalkaranji, Tal. Hatkanangale, Dist. Kolhapur. Deceased Shobha Shelake was unmarried. The applicant was look after of deceased Shobha Shelake after the death of their parents. Applicant is only legal heir of deceased Shobha Shelake and apart from her, there are no other legal heirs of deceased. Deceased Shobha Shelake having immovable property. Therefore, to record name of applicant on property, it is necessary to submit the heirship certificate of the deceased Shobha Shelake.

3. Accordingly, paper publication (Exh. 07) was published in daily newspaper namely 'Mahankarya'. But no one appeared and raised the objection. The applicant Archana Ashok Ghatge has adduced her evidence by filing her affidavit below Exh. 08 in support of her contention. She has deposed as per her contention. The documents filed by the applicant alongwith Exh. 3 shows that deceased **Shobha Bandu Shelake** died on 15.11.2020 The applicant has filed true copy of Death certificate of deceased **Shobha Bandu Shelake**, copy of Aadhar card and voting card of deceased.

Applicant has filed evidence close pursis at Exh. 11. These documents and the evidence adduced by the applicant on affidavit shows that, the applicant is the legal heir of deceased **Shobha Bandu Shelake**. Hence, in view of evidence adduced and documents filed on record, I pass the following order-

::ORDER::

1. The heir-ship certificate be issued in the name of the applicant **Archana Ashok Ghatge** after necessary compliance.
2. Application is disposed off accordingly.
