



**ORDER PASSED BELOW EXH.1 IN
Cri.Bail Appln. No.7/2026**

This is an application filed by accused Yuvraj Ananda Mali for anticipatory bail U/s.482 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) in Crime No.343/2025 for the offence punishable U/s.303(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023, U/s.48(7) and 48(8) of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code, registered at police station, Shirol.

2. Facts in brief are as under :-

Complainant Vinayak Arage is serving as circle officer at Shirol. Original complainant Ashok Mane filed complaint application to Tahsildar Shirol and on 08-08-2025, Tahsildar Shirol directed the complainant to make inquiry. The application was about the excavation of murum of 53 brass in the land of Ashok Mane in Gat No.2981 admeasuring area 0.98R. Accordingly, complainant visited the spot. He found that murum was stolen. He prepared panchanama. Complainant lodged report in the police station.

3] On the report, crime is registered and investigation is started. It is resulted that accused Yuvraj excavated the murum from the land of Ashok Mane and committed theft. Investigation is in progress.

4] Mr.B.V.Patil advocate for accused submitted that accused is innocent and he has not committed any crime. He has drawn my attention towards the documents on record and submitted that accused is falsely implicated in the present crime. Complainant has filed false complaint to Revenue officer. In fact there is no recovery at

the instance of accused. His custodial interrogation is not necessary. He is ready to abide by the conditions imposed by the court. He prayed to grant anticipatory bail to accused.

5] Mr.U.M.Kulkarni, learned APP for the state has submitted that offence is serious. Accused committed the theft of 53 brass murum from the land of Ashok Mane. Detail investigation is necessary. He prayed to reject the application.

6] De facto complainant appeared and filed his objection at Exh.9. According to him, accused committed the theft of 53 brass murum in his land.

7] I have perused the FIR and documents on record. It appears that there is theft of murum from the land of de facto complainant Ashok Mane. Complainant filed photographs showing that JCB and dumper are standing in the land. The Revenue officer came to the conclusion that theft of murum is occurred. Therefore, I find that offence is serious. The custodial interrogation of accused is necessary. Hence, in such circumstances, accused is not entitled for anticipatory bail. Therefore, following order;

:ORDER:

(1) Application is rejected.
