SUMMARY CRIMINAL CASE NO.299/2026
Shri. Balumama Enterprises through Shri. Rohit Ramchandra Banne Vs. Shri. Samarth Ashok Vadar

Perused the complaint, documents attached along with. Heard learned advocate for the complainant.

2. The offence alleged in the complaint against the accused is punishable under section 138 of Negotiable Instrument Act, 1881. The accused is residing beyond territorial jurisdiction of this court. Hon'ble Supreme Court directed that, inquiry under section 225 of The Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (*In short "B.N.S.S."*) shall be conducted on complaint under 138 of N.I. Act to come to issuance of process under section 227 of *B.N.S.S.* against the accused. If the accused is residing beyond territorial jurisdiction the court has to satisfy itself upon documents submitted by the complainant along with complaint or inquiry under section 225 of *B.N.S.S.* I think it is fit case to pass order for postponement of issue process for the purpose of deciding whether or not there are sufficient grounds for proceeding against the accused. Hence, the order -

ORDER

1. Complainant is directed to give evidence through witnesses, if he desires for the purpose of inquiry under section 225 of *B.N.S.S.*
2. Issue process is postponed vide section 225 of *B.N.S.S.*
