ORDER BELOW EXH. 1 IN

CRIMINAL MISC.APPLICATION NO.58/2026

Ajay Nandkishor Bhattad and another

VS.

State of Maharashtra

This is an application made by the applicants for re-transfer the hold amount Rs.75,86,885.81/- in the account of the applicants.

02. It is the contention in the application and argument that, Cyber Cell department (S.P. Office, Kolhapur) Police Station, Jaysingpur, has hold the amount of applicants as per acknowledgment No.1) 31902260024773 and 2) 31902260029220. The said amount has been transferred from the account of the applicants. Now it is holded on their complaint. Now, the applicants has apprehension that if the said amount kept lying, there is a possibility that accused may misuse or withdraw or transfer the said amount. Therefore, irreparable loss would be caused to the applicants. Hence, prayed for direction against the Cyber Cell (S.P. Office, Kolhapur) to re-transfer the said amount in their account. Further, the applicants are also ready and willing to abide all terms and condition imposed by the Court. Accordingly, prayed for allowing this application.

03. Accordingly, say of Cyber Cell, Jaysingpur Police Station and Ld.APP was called for. By filing their say the Cyber Cell department (S.P. Office, Kolhapur) submitted that, as per the contention of applicants the said amount is hold. Further, they have no objection to re-transfer the hold amount in favour of applicants. Jaysingpur Police Station also filed their say and they have also no any objection for the same. On the contrary Ld.APP prayed for necessary order be passed.

04. Perused the application, say, record and proceeding. Heard both sides at sufficient length. The applicants filed computerized print of online complaint with the Cyber Cell. Acknowledgment No.1) 31902260024773 and 2) 31902260029220, verified copy of aadhar card of the applicant No.1 and verified copy of pan card of the applicant No.1. On perusal of the online complaint and record it is evident that the applicants is not the accused in this crime. Accordingly F.I.R. is lodged. Investigation would take some time. On perusal of say of I.O. it evident that the amount supra was hold from the account of applicants. Hence, no purpose would be served by keeping the holded amount. The Cyber Cell department and Jaysingpur Police Station has given the no objection. It is important to note that no any person other than the applicants has claimed the amount. Accordingly, I pass the following order -

: ORDER :

1] The application is allowed in the following terms :

- a] The Cyber Cell department (S.P. Office, Kolhapur) Police Station Jaysingpur is directed to re-transfer the holded amount of Rs.75,86,885.81/- in the account of applicants from where the online complaint was lodged on their executing indemnity bond to the sum of Rs.75,86,885.81/- (Rs. Seventy Five Lakh Eighty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Five Rupees and Eighty-One Paise only) before the concerned police officer.
- b) I.O. is directed to keep the copy of this order with the complaint.
