-: **ORDER**:-

Today, the accused namely **Mahesh Barsing Rajput** is appeared before the court. The accused is identified by his Ld. Advocate. The accused refused free legal aid offered to him and stated that he does not wish to go for trial. The accused appeared and voluntarily pleaded guilty and accordingly filed the pursis.

I have personally verified the fact of his voluntary plea guilty from him. I have explained to him the maximum punishment for the said offence and consequences of admitting guilt, even though he pleaded guilty. Upon questioning him I am satisfied that his plea is voluntarily and hence, it is accepted. On the point of sentence, the Ld. APP orally submitted that the maximum sentence needs to be awarded to the accused. Per contra, the Ld. Adv. for the accused orally submitted that leniency needs to be shown with the accused, in parallel, the accused orally submitted that he is the only bread earner for his family, he is very poor and prayed for leniency. Prosecution not filed any record which shows that the present accused is habitual offender. In my view, considering the submissions and the nature of offence, leniency would suffice. Hence, I pass the following order -

ORDER

1.	The accused namely Mahesh Barsing Rajput , R/o: Hanuman Nagar, Mouje Aagar, Tal.Shirol, Dist.Kolhapur is hereby convicted u/s. 275 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 for the offence punishable u/s.75[A] of Maharashtra Prohibition Act, 1949 and he is sentenced to suffer simple imprisonment till rising of this court and also pay fine amount of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) in default of payment of fine amount, to suffer simple imprisonment for 02 days.
2.	The copy of this order be given to the accused, free of cost.
