This is an application filed by defendant Nos. 7 and 8 for permission to file written statement. Plaintiffs filed their say overleaf the said application and opposed the application. Heard learned Advocates for both sides.

02. Perusal of the record shows that suit summons were served on defendant Nos. 7 and 8 on 01/07/2022. Thereafter, defendant Nos. 7 and 8 failed to appear before the Court personally or through their advocate. Till today 'Ex-parte' order is not passed against defendant Nos. 7 and 8, but delay caused to appear in the suit and to file written statement. Therefore, to avoid technical difficulties, they filed this application. The present suit is for perpetual injunction. Thus, in order to decide the suit on merit, it would be justifiable to allow the defendant Nos. 7 and 8 to file their written statement on the record of the suit. However, at the same time delay caused by defendant Nos. 7 and 8 needs to be compensated. Hence, the application is allowed subject to cost of Rs.100/- (Rupees One Hundred only) to be given to plaintiffs.
