


MHKO080000292026 	<u>Order Below Exh. 51 in Misc. Civil Appeal</u> <u>No. 01/2026</u> [Mahadev Patil Vs. Secretary Devsthan Committee and others.]

01. This court has dismissed the present Misc. Civil Appeal. However, during pendency of the present appeal this Court has directed the respondent (original defendant) to maintain status-quo (Exh.27) till next scheduled date. The order of status-quo (Exh.27) dated 17/02/2026 was subsequently extended till 23/04/2026. On 23/04/2026 this Court has extended the order of status-quo (Exh.27) till final adjudication of the present appeal as per order below Exh.44. Today this Court has dismissed the present Misc. Civil Appeal and therefore, the appellants have moved present application for extension of status-quo order (Exh.27) till writ/appeal period as they are intending to move to the Hon'ble Bombay High Court against the order passed by this Court.

02. The application is strongly opposed by the respondent stating that, the construction work of the temple is about to complete and further delay is seriously affecting the smooth development of the construction of the temple.

03. As both the Ld. Counsels on record have co-operated this Court to dispose of the present Misc. Civil Appeal at the earliest and the status-quo order (Exh.27) was in force till today. An opportunity to approach to the Hon'ble Bombay High Court is a legal right of the appellants. Therefore, some breathing period is required to be given to the appellants and therefore, the order of status-quo (Exh.27) granted

by this Court till today needs to be extended for four weeks from today. Hence following order is passed :-

ORDER

1. Application (Exh.51) is allowed.
2. The order of status-quo (Exh.27) dated 17/02/2026 extended till today is continued for four weeks from today.
