**Order below Exh.No. 1 in M.A.C. Petition
No.1/2024**

Mr. Shivaji Shankar Patil
Vs.
ICICI Lombard General Insurance Co. Ltd.
and Anr.

1. In view of terms of pursis passed by Hon'ble Lokadalat below Exh.29, compromise terms at Exh.28 filed by both the parties, it is clear that the matter is compromised between the applicant and opponent No.1 for an amount of Rs.4,50,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) towards full and final settlement including 'NFL'. The applicant withdrawn the application against opponent No.2. Hence, following order is passed.

ORDER

- 1] The M.A.C.P No. 1/2024 is disposed of as compromised in view of compromise pursis (Exh.28) and compromise memo (Exh.29).
- 2] The case is withdrawn against opponent No. 2.
- 3] The opponent 1 is directed to pay compensation amount of Rs.4,50,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Fifty Thousand only) inclusive of N.F.L. amount.
- 4] If opponent No.1 Insurance Company failed to pay the compensation amount within a period of 60 days, then it shall pay interest at the rate of 9% per annum.
- 5] Opponent No.1 shall pay the amount either through **RTGS** or **NEFT** in the bank account maintained by the Tribunal. The details of the bank account are as under :-

- 6] The petitioner should produce his Savings bank account of any Nationalized bank.
- 7] After deposit of the said amount, it be paid to the petitioner by account payee cheque.
- 8] The copy of award be sent to the Insurance Company by E-Mail. After depositing the compensation amount into the above-mentioned bank account, the Insurance Company shall inform the Tribunal by sending E-mail accordingly.
- 9] The petitioner is entitled to get refund of court fees as per rule.
- 10] Award be drawn accordingly.
