1. By way of instant application the petitioner crave leave for deleting the name of petitioner No.5 from present claim.

2. It is urged by the applicant that petitioner No.5 breathed her last on 27/12/2023 by leaving behind her petitioner Nos.1 to 4 as legal representatives. There are no other LRs. of deceased petitioner No.5. They are already on record. Therefore, applicants implored for deleting the name of petitioner No.5 from the claim.

3. Opponent No.3 caused appearance before the court and raised stiff objection for allowing the application. Rest of the opponents did not opt to file reply.

4. Heard both sides. I have pondered over entire record minutely. The copy of death certificate annexed herewith speaks into volume that petitioner No.5 expired on 27/12/2023. Her legal representatives are already on record. Therefore, there is nothing on record to disown the reliefs claimed by the applicants. Since LRs of the deceased are already before the court, it is just and necessary to delete the name of petitioner No.5 from the record. Hence, the order.

Order

1. Application is allowed.
2. Petitioners are permitted to delete the name of petitioner No.5 from the claim proceeding.

3. Petitioner Nos.1 to 4 shall place amended copy of claim petition on record.
