



ORDER PASSED BELOW EXH.22
IN REGULAR CIVIL SUIT NO.91/2025

Read application. Heard Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff. The application is duly supported by affidavit. It is the contention of the plaintiff that the defendant nos.7 and 8 may take forceful possession of the suit properties. If the defendant nos.7 and 8 are succeeded, then the whole purpose of filing the suit will be frustrated.

2. I have given thoughtful consideration to the argument advanced by the plaintiff. Perused the suit. The plaintiff is claiming partition in the suit properties. It is the prime contention of the plaintiff that she is having 1/16th share in the suit properties. Therefore, before deciding the application filed below Exh.5 i.e. interim injunction application, if the defendant nos.7 and 8 taken the possession of the suit properties, then the whole purpose of filing suit will be frustrated. Here, the delay would defeat the purpose. Hence, I am of the view that if till the appearance of defendant nos.7 and 8, an interim protection is granted, then it will suffice the purpose. Thus, I pass the following order :-

ORDER

Defendant nos.7 and 8 are directed to maintain status-quo regarding the suit properties till their appearance.
