**ORDER BELOW EXH. 5 IN REG. CIVIL SUIT NO. 110/2020**

1. On previous dates, Ld. Advocate for defendant Nos. 6 to 9 Shri. Kadukar submitted that Exh. 5 is to be heard and disposed of expeditiously, particularly because the ex-parte interim order is in force against the defendants and therefore, they are finding it difficult to deal with the suit properties. Considering this submission of the defendants, the suit was posted on 27.06.2023 and 30.06.2023 i.e. today.
2. When the matter is taken up for hearing, it is submitted by Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff that no such interim order is now in force. It has been already discontinued. Therefore, there is no need to take any urgent hearing. After hearing the parties at length, it is unanimously submitted by both the Ld. Advocates that the matter can be listed for issues instead of taking hearing of Exh. 5. Considering the submission advanced at bar, application Exh. 5 will be decided at the final disposal.
3. With assistance of both the Ld. Advocates, the issues will be framed expeditiously.
