



**COMMON ORDER BELOW EXH.39 & 40**  
**IN REGULAR CIVIL SUIT NO.152/2025**

[ CNR No.MHKO090004892025 ]

The plaintiff filed both the applications under Order V Rule 20 of Civil Procedure Code for issuance of summons by affixing on the Court-yard and also also by way of paper publication as the defendant no.1 is avoiding the service of summons. It is specifically argued that the summons was issued on the address of Aadhar card of defendant no.1. However, said summons was unserved on the endorsement of postal office. Therefore, it is necessary to issue suit summons to the defendant under Order V Rule 20 of CPC, as it is not possible to serve the summons in ordinary mode.

2. Heard Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff. The plaintiff wants to issue suit summons on two addresses, one address which is local and another address is the address, which is shown on the Aadhar card as well as shown in the sale-deed. The contention of the plaintiff is duly supported by affidavit. Thus there are sufficient grounds to issue suit summons under Order V Rule 20 of CPC. Thus, I pass the following order:

**ORDER**

- 1] Issue suit summons under Order V Rule 20 of CPC.

- 2] Issue proclamation to the defendant no.1 in daily local newspaper as well as summons to be served by affixing copy thereof in conspicuous place in the Court house and also upon conspicuous part of house in which defendant no.1 is known to have last resided and on the address given in the plaint.
