



**Vijaykumar Bandappa Ghugre & Ors.,
Vs.
The State of Maharashtra,
through Collector, Kolhapur**

1. This suit is filed by the plaintiffs for declaration and perpetual injunction. Pending this suit, the plaintiffs and defendant No. 5 to 13 arrived at amicable settlement and prepared compromise deed. As the State i.e. defendant No.1 to 4 were formal parties, the plaintiffs before settlement, deleted the defendant No. 1 to 4 (The Collector, Kolhapur, Tahsildar, Gadhinglaj, TILR, Gadhinglaj and The Town Planning Authority, Kolhapur) by filing application below Exh. 65. The application is allowed today itself and the plaintiff then filed amended plaint Exh.1/1.

2. Today both plaintiffs and defendant Nos. 5 to 13 are present along with their Ld. Advocates. They filed on record compromise deed below Exh. 67 and submitted that, they accept the terms and conditions of the compromise deed and will abide by its terms and conditions and requested to disposed of this suit as per compromise deed.

3. Hence, permission is granted to the parties to settle the dispute amicably and accordingly, I pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1) This suit is disposed of as compromise in view of compromise deed Exh. 67.
- 2) Both parties shall bear their own costs.
- 3) Decree be drawn up accordingly.
