**ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT NO. 1**

- 01.** This is an application filed under Section 2 of the Bombay Regulation Act, 1827 for grant of heirship certificate.
- 02.** The applicants submitted that, deceased Amrut Laxman Pawar was husband of applicant no.1, father of applicant no.2 and son of applicant no.3 and 4. He was died on 12/10/2025. There are no other legal heirs to deceased except them.
- 03.** After the death of deceased Amrut Laxman Pawar, applicants require the heirship certificate for Government and Semi-government purposes. Hence, they prayed to allow this application and be issued heirship certificate in their name.
- 04.** On dated 09/02/2026, proclamation has been issued in the daily newspaper “Dakshin Maharashtra Kesari” and citation notice for calling any objections in public at large. But, till today no objection is received.
- 05.** On perusal of contentions mentioned in the application following points arise for my determination. I give my findings thereon for the reasons given below.

**:: REASONS ::**

**As to point no.1 :-**

06. In order to support the claim, applicants have filed death certificates of deceased Amrut Laxman Pawar and verified copies of their Aadhar-cards at Exh.3 and 13.

07. In addition, applicant No.1 Suvarna Amrut Pawar has filed her evidence affidavit at Exh.9, which is nothing, but replica of Exh.1. They have filed evidence close pursis at Exh.10. Nobody has challenged her evidence till today. Therefore, there is no reason to disbelieve her testimony and documents produced on record.

08. Heard learned advocate for the applicants at length. Considering the need of heirship certificate, I am of the opinion that, applicant no.1 to 3 are class-I heirs, therefore, they are only entitled for heirship certificate of deceased. Applicant no.4 is a father of deceased and he comes in category of class-II heirs, therefore, he is not entitled to claim heirship certificate. In above reason, I answered to point no.1 **in partly affirmative.**

**As to point no.2:-**

09. In view of my finding to point no.1, I proceed to pass following order.

**:: ORDER ::**

01. Application is partly allowed.
02. Issue heirship certificate of **deceased Amrut Laxman Pawar** in the name of applicant No. 1] Suvarna Amrut Pawar, 2] Anuj Amrut Pawar and 3] Shevanta Laxman Pawar only on payment of requisite Court fee as per rules.
