ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT NO.24

The present application is filed for bringing legal representatives of the deceased applicant Basappa Ramu Halagadgi on record.

02. It is contended that, applicant Basappa Ramu Halagadgi died on 08/03/2025 and there are no other legal representatives of deceased applicant except those are mentioned in instant application. This application is supported by an affidavit.

03. Say of other sides was called and opponents filed say overleaf and submitted that, the applicant are trying to prolong the matter for unnecessary reasons. The applicant is deceased in month of March 2025 no any reason are been mentioned for the delay. Hence, be rejected with heavy cost.

04. In view of Article-120 of Limitation Act, the application for bringing legal representatives of deceased applicants or opponents ought to have filed within 90 days from the date of death of deceased applicants or opponents. In instant matter death extract of deceased applicant Basappa Ramu Halagadgi shows that, he died on 08/03/2025 and instant application is moved on 12/12/2025, which is not within the period of limitation. However, as per order passed below Exh.22 & 23 delay caused in bringing legal representatives on record is condoned. Further, opponents no where denied that, the legal representatives mentioned in application are

not representatives of deceased applicant. Therefore, there is no hurdle to allow the instant application. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

:- ORDER :-

1. Application is allowed and applicants are permitted to bring the legal representatives of deceased applicant Basappa Ramu Halagadgi on record after compliance of costs imposed as per Exh.22 and 23.
2. The applicants shall carry out the necessary amendment in plaint within 14 days and shall supply the amended copy of plaint.
