ORDER

1. Accused namely **Sagar Tanaji Jadhav** is hereby convicted vide section 185 of Motor Vehicle Act vide section 275 of the B.N.S.S. Act, and sentence pay of fine of Rs.10,000/- (In words Rupees Ten Thousand only) in default of payment of fine he shall suffer simple imprisonment for Three days.
2. Accused also convicted vide section 3/181 of Motor Vehicle Act vide section 275 of the B.N.S.S. Act, and sentence pay of fine of Rs.5,000/- (In words Rupees Five Thousand only) in default of payment of fine he shall suffer simple imprisonment for Three days.
