Present suit is filed for partition. The case is referred for mediation by the order of this Court and Trained Mediator Shri. M. P. Patil, was appointed as a Mediator.

2. The case is compromised before the mediator and mediator has filed the report at Exh.20. The parties have filed the compromise pursis at Exh.21 stating that in view of the terms of the compromise, they do not want to proceed with the suit as the matter is compromised between them. The Court has ascertained the voluntariness of the pursis Exh.21. Both the parties and their advocates are present and admitted the contents of it. They have stated that suit may be disposed off in terms of pursis. Pursis is read & recorded. Considering this, I pass the following order.

(2)	Parties shall bear their own costs.
(3)	Compromise decree be made accordingly.
(4)	Compromise pursis vide exh.21 shall be treated as part and parcel of compromise

	decree.
(5)	Issue Court Fee refund certificate as per rules.
