ORDER BELOW EXH. 01

1. The applicant along with her learned advocate is present before me today and applicant submitted the present withdrawal pursis in the present matter.

2. The applicant submitted that due to amicable settlement, she does not want to proceed with the present matter and wants to withdraw the same. Hence, applicant wants to withdraw the present matter. Applicant admits the contents of pursis (Exh.21) and her signature thereupon. I have verified the applicant. The applicant contended that she do not want to proceed with the matter and wants to withdraw the present matter due to amicable settlement. Moreover, learned advocate for the applicant also signed the pursis and admitted the fact of amicable settlement in the present matter.

3. The applicant has desired to withdraw the application as she do not want to proceed with the matter as the dispute is amicably resolved. Accordingly, applicant and opponent no.1 had obtained divorce vide Sec. 28 of the Special Marriage Act. Hence, in view of the withdrawal pursis (Exh.21), the matter is deserved to be disposed off as withdrawn. Considering all these aspects and in the interest of justice, I proceed to pass the following order :-

ORDER

1. The application stands disposed off as withdrawn.
2. Both parties to bear their own costs.
