1. This application is filed by defendant no. 3(C) to setting aside no w.s. order passed against her.
2. It is submitted on behalf of learned advocate of the defendant no. 3(C) that, there is no intentional delay to file w.s. Defendant no. 3(C) is studying external M.Com. and she is doing private job in pune. Therefore, she could not approach her advocate for filing of w.s. Hence, prayed to set aside no w.s. order with permission to file w.s.
3. Say to this application filed by plaintiff. It is submitted that, there is intentional delay. This application is filed just to prolong the matter. So also, 94 days delay for filing this application. Alternatively, prayed by imposing heavy costs upon defendants. Hence, urged to reject the application.
