ORDER BELOW EXH. 01

When called out repeatedly applicant, opponent & their learned advocate are absent. On perusal of record it appears that the present application is filed by the applicants vide Section 54 of the Code of Civil Procedure, for effecting the partition in view of the decree dated 22/11/2019 which is passed in R.C.S. No. 111/2014. More importantly, it appears that vide order below Exh. 1 dated 19/01/2022 my learned predecessor passed the order in view of section 54 of Code of Civil Procedure.
