

	<u>ORDER BELOW EXH. NO. 14 IN R.C.S. NO. 191/2021</u>
	<u>Ashwini Sushant Ghatage Vs. Shripati Bandu Pawar etc.09</u>

By way of this application, filed under Order VII, r. 14 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (hereinafter referred to as 'the C.P.C. for the sake of brevity), defendant No. 10 contends that, plaintiff has not provided other documents which she has filed along with the plaint in the present suit to him. Plaintiff is supposed to file the documents as per O. VII, r. 14 of the C.P.C. Hence, the plaintiff be directed to provide the documents. Plaintiff has resisted this application and contended that, plaintiff has already filed the documents and there is an urgency to adjudicate on the interim application.

02. Perused the documents. Heard both the sides as per O. VII, R. 14 of the C.P.C., it is expected that, plaintiff shall produce in Court, when plaint is presented by him, all the documents which she intends to sue-upon or intends to rely upon which are in her possession or power in support of her claim and shall also deliver the documents at the same time and the copy of thereof to be filed alongwith the plaint. Thus, duty is casted on the plaintiff to produce all the documents which is relevant for the present suit. However, it appears that from the record of the case that plaintiff have provided all the necessary documents which have been filed along with the plaint to the defendants. Hence, the present application has become
