This is an application moved by the defendant No.2C under Order 9 Rule 13 of the Code of Civil Procedure for setting aside ex-parte order passed against him.

2) Heard learned advocate B.G. Kamble for the defendant No.2C and learned advocate Shri. N.G. Ajarekar for the plaintiff. Perused the application and say.

3) The perusal of application does not reveal any satisfactory reason for setting aside ex-parte order passed against defendant No.2C. Howsoever, considering the principle of natural justice i. e. no man should be condemned unheard, application deserves to be allowed by imposing costs. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

Order

1. Application is allowed subject to payment of costs of Rs.300/- (Rupees three hundred only) paid to the plaintiff on or before next date.

2. After compliance of above clause, necessary order will be passed on Exh.1.

3. Failure to comply above clause on or before next date, the application shall be deemed to be rejected.
