

	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>ORDER BELOW EXH. 25 IN R.C.S. NO. 42/2014</u> <u>Shivaji Govind Patil, etc. Vs. Annappa Vithoba Patil,</u> <u>etc.</u></p>

This is a suit for declaration and perpetual injunction. By application filed at Exh. 25, the plaintiffs prayed to grant them permission to bring L.Rs. of deceased plaintiff No. 3. In the application it is contended that, plaintiff No. 3 died on 11/11/2018. Further it is contended that, the deceased plaintiff No. 3 has left behind L.Rs. as describe in paragraph No. 2 of the application. Thus, the plaintiffs sought permission to bring L.Rs. of deceased plaintiff No. 3 on record. Application is supported with affidavit.

2. The application is strongly apposed and contested by the defendants. However, the prayed to pass necessary order.

3. Heard, Shri. S.S. Kot, the Id. Advocate for the plaintiffs and Smt. C.S. Patil, the Id. Advocate for the defendants.

4. It is a matter of record that, plaintiff No. 3 died on 11/11/2018. As regards names of the proposed L.R. of deceased plaintiff No. 3, the defendants have no objection. Considering the nature of the suit presence of L.R. of deceased plaintiff No. 3 is necessary. There would be no hardship to the defendants if the application is allowed. On the contrary, if the application is not allowed, there would be loss to the plaintiff. Thus, the application deserves to be allowed. Hence, following order.

ORDER

The application below Exh. 25 is allowed.

The plaintiffs are permitted to bring L.R. of deceased plaintiff No. 3 on record whose names are mentioned in para No. 2 of the application.

The plaintiff to carry out necessary amendment in the plaint title within 14 days for passing of this order and

also to file amended copy of the plaint along with copies thereof to supply them to all the defendants on record and also to file a copy of the amended plaint for preparation of decree.
