

**ORDER BELOW EXH. 14 IN R.C.S. NO. 112/2018**

Vaiju Satuppa Uchagoankar Vs. Narayan Dattu Bhongale

This is the suit for partition and perpetual injunction. By this application, the plaintiffs prayed to grant them permission to file some documents on record along with list Exh. 15. According to the plaintiff, the documents he proposed to file are important in order to decide the application at Exh. 5. Hence, prayed accordingly.

2. The application is strongly contested and opposed by the defendants by filing their say at the bottom of the application itself. They prayed to reject the application.

3. Heard, Shri. S.S. Kot, Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff and Shri. V.B. Kadukar, the Ld. Advocate for the defendants.

4. On perusal of the list Exh. 15 it transpired that, all the documents proposed to file are public documents. Considering the nature of the document, there appears no hardship to the defendant side if this document comes on record. Moreover, mere filing of the documents will not mean that they are proved but, party filing such documents must prove them according to provisions of the law. Hence, following order.

The plaintiff is permitted to file documents as per list Exh. 15 subject to proof of according to law.
