ORDER BELOW EXH. 1.

Heard counsels for both sides at considerable length. Complainant examined herself along with other two witnesses similarly as examined for issuance of process. All witnesses have specifically lead evidence in respect of cheating, dishonestly and fraudulently execution of relinquishment deed against accused. Neighter witness deposed nor specified any alleged act in respect of mischief intentional insult and criminal intimidation.

2. This court issued process against accused for an offence punishable U/sec. 420, 423, 426, 465, 504 & 506 r/w 34 of I. P. Code. However, considering the evidence before charge lead by complainant, accused are need to be tried for an offence punishable U/sec. 420, 423, 465 of I. P. Code. No offence U/sec. 426, 504 & 506 made out against accused. Therefore, considering above discussion, I pass following order,

ORDER

1. Accused are tried for offence punishable U/sec. 420, 423, 465 r/w 34 of I. P. Code.
2. Accused are discharged for the offence punishable U/sec.426, 504 & 506 r/w 34 of I. P. Code.
3. Complainant and accused to take note.
