**ORDER PASSED BELOW EXH. 1**

Today, complainant society A. R. and his counsel are present. They have filed pursis at Exh.24 for withdrawal of case and society A. R. admitted its contents along with his signature. He submitted that, accused has paid whole cheque amount and therefore his society not willing to proceed further. The outside compromise between parties is one of the ground for grant permission to withdraw case. Thus, considering pursis at Exh.24, I pass following order:

- 1) Complaint is disposed of as withdrawn U/Sec. 257 of Cr. P. Code.
- 2) Accused is acquitted and his bail bonds stands cancelled.
- 3) Original document, if any filed by parties be return to them as per rule.
- 4) Court fees be refund to the complainant as per rule.
