2. Perused record. Case is more than five months old and pending for appearance of accused. Considering the fact that, present case is summary case, it ought to have been decided till such period of its pendency. Despite granting sufficient opportunity prosecution failed to secure presence of accused.

3. Despite that, no efforts have been taken by prosecution to produce accused, even report of summons not filed. Thus, no purpose would be served by keeping this case still pending for further more time. For these reasons, I think it is fit to stop proceeding of present summons case under section 281 of B. N. S. Sanhita Hence, I pass the following order,

2. Accused is discharged.
