ORDER BELOW EXH.01 IN
S.C.C.NO.24/2021

Today, there is special drive for disposing still and ineffective cases as per the directions of Hon'ble High Court, Bombay & Hon'ble Maharashtra State Legal Services Authority.

The complainant is absent when called repeatedly. From the record it appears that, offences levelled against the accused is under Section 138 of N.I. Act. The case is pending for hearing for more than seven years. In spite of sufficient opportunity, the complainant has failed to take appropriate steps for securing presence of accused. Therefore, the case is kept for dismissal order since 17/02/2026. In spite of that complainant failed to take appropriate steps. Today also, complainant and his learned advocate are absent when called till 5:30 p.m. Consequently, in the prevailing circumstances, it would not be justifiable to keep the said case pending. Pursuant to the aforesaid conclusion, I pass following order.

ORDER

- 1] This proceeding of the case is hereby stopped as per Section 279 of B.N.S.S. 2023.
- 2] The accused is acquitted for the offence punishable under Section 138 of N.I. Act.
- 3] Bail bond of accused stands cancelled, if any.
