


MHKO160001562026 	<u>ORDER BELOW EXH. 1 IN</u> <u>CRI.M.A.NO.04/2026</u>

1. The applicant has filed this application under Section 503 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023 for hand over the vehicle in his favour.

2. It is the case of the applicant that he is the registered owner Maruti Suzuki Dzire VXi petrol vehicle of Maruti Suzuki India Ltd. having registration No. HR20AL9450, Chassis No.-MA3CZF63SHM241981 Engine No. K12MN2126090 (Above mentioned Maruti Suzuki Dzire VXi petrol vehicle of Maruti Suzuki India Ltd. is hereinafter referred to as, 'the vehicle').

3. It is further case of the applicant that the vehicle is being used for his daily needs. Police have seized the vehicle in Crime No.346/2025, Shahuwadi Police station. The vehicle is kept in open place without any use in the police station where proper care and protection is not taken. Therefore, the vehicle is being damaged. The applicant is ready to abide by the conditions which will be imposed while handing over the vehicle in his favour. Finally, he prayed to hand over the vehicle in his favour.

4. The I.O. and learned A.P.P. have filed their say to the application. They opposed the application and submitted that the vehicle may be misused for illegal offences if released, it can be exchanged or sold or altered if released, the vehicle is required for

the purpose of trial, and, lastly prayed to reject the application.

5. Heard Ld. Advocate for the applicant, learned A.PP and I.O. Perused report in C.R.No.346/2025, copy of temporary registration certificate of the vehicle, copy of insurance policy of the vehicle, copy of F.I.R. & copy of Adhar Card of the applicant. Admittedly, the vehicle is owned & possessed by the applicant. The vehicle can be used in similar kind of offences, the vehicle can be altered if released and the vehicle is required for the purpose of trial are not the good grounds to reject the application. What is required during the pendency of the case is safe custody of the vehicle and it's production before the court as and when required by the court to do so. The applicant is ready to abide by conditions which will be imposed by this court while handing over the vehicle in his favour.

6. Considering all above aspects it will be proper to pass following order.

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. The vehicle be released in favour of the applicant on furnishing indemnity bond of Rs.-7,00,000/- (Rs. Seven Lac only) before Police.
3. The applicant shall produce the vehicle before the court as and when required by the court to do so during trial or at any time thereafter.
4. The applicant shall not transfer the vehicle, shall not change its appearance in any manner without the leave of the court.

5. Police Station – Shahuwadi is directed to take 3 colored photographs of the vehicle from different angles clearly displaying Engine number, Chassis number and other particulars of the vehicle and shall submit it along with final report. Expenses of the photographs shall be born by the applicant.
6. The applicant shall not use or allow the vehicle to be used for any illegal purposes.
7. The applicant shall co-operate police in the investigation of the crime and shall produce all relevant documents of the vehicle before I.O. for verification and investigation purposes.
