Ans. Yes.


Que. 3. Do you plead guilty ?

Judgment on plead of guilty


1) Accused has been prosecuted for the offence punishable under Section 185 of the Motor Vehicles Act. Accused appeared before the Court, filed pursis at Exhibit 2 and voluntarily pleaded guilty for the offence leveled against him. I made him aware about the nature and punishment of offence and consequences of pleading guilty. The plead guilty is voluntary. Considering the nature of the offence and the punishment prescribed for the same I accept the plea of accused.

2) Heard Id.A.PP. and accused on the point of sentence. Accused submitted that it is his first offence, therefore lenient view may kindly be taken into account while award in the sentence. Considering the age of the accused, nature of the offence it will not just and proper to pass stringent punishment. Considering all these circumstances, the Court pass the following order.

ORDER

- i) Accused is hereby convicted for the offence punishable under Section 185 of the Motor Vehicles Act *vide* section 275 of Code of Bahratiya Nagrik Surksha Sanhita-2023 and sentenced to pay fine of Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two thousand Only) in default of payment of fine accused to suffer simple imprisonment for three (3) days.
