If no settlement is reached, neither the parties, advocates nor the mediator may disclose to this Court anything that was discussed at the mediation.

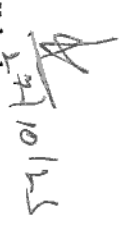
Shri. S. N. Patil trained advocate mediator is appointed as mediator. Parties are directed to appear before the Mediator.

If the report of mediation is not received to this Court within 60 days of this order, or if no extension of time is sought for mediation, the parties much proceed with the trial of this case from the 61st day.

Attendance for mediation does not mean that, this case is stayed or parties are not supposed to attend the dates of this case either in person or through their learned advocate.

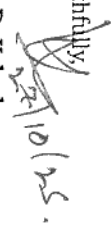
