



ORDER BELOW EXH.01 IN R.C.S.NO.87/2025
[Nagesh Ashok Pattekari v. Pushpa Ashok Pattekari
and Ors.]

The plaintiff, the defendant and their learned advocates are present before the Court. The suit was referred for mediation to the Hon'ble Trained Mediator Judge. In view of report (Exh.10) of the Hon'ble Trained Mediator Judge and joint compromise pursis (Exh.11) filed by both the parties, it shows that, the matter is amicably settled between the parties as per terms and conditions mentioned in compromise pursis (Exh.11). Both the parties have voluntarily admitted correctness of contents of compromise pursis (Exh.11) before the Court. Hence, compromise pursis (Exh.11) came to be read and recorded as per order passed thereon. Both the parties and their learned advocates have prayed that, the suit may be decreed as per compromise pursis (Exh.11).

02. Considering aforesaid facts and submissions of both parties and their learned advocates, it will be just and proper to decree the suit as per compromise pursis (Exh.11). Resultantly, I pass following order :

ORDER

1. The suit is decreed in terms of compromise pursis (Exh.11).
2. Decree be drawn in terms of compromise pursis (Exh.11), which shall form part of the decree.
3. Court-fees be refunded as per rule.
